17.44.080 Livestock/Animals.

- A. The keeping of livestock and poultry is subject to the following provisions:
1. The property shall be maintained in a clean, sanitary condition so as to be free from offensive odors, fly breeding, dust and general nuisances, and to be in compliance with the Chelan-Douglas Health District regulations.
 2. Adequate measures shall be taken to properly dispose of animal wastes. Accumulation of animal waste shall be prohibited from being stored closer than 100 feet from any off premises dwelling and domestic or irrigation well.
- B. It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep, harbor or maintain within the corporate limits of the town, any livestock without first having procured a permit to do so from the town council in the manner provided in this chapter:
1. Application for the permit required by WMC 17.44.080(c) (2) shall be made in writing to the Town Council by the person desiring such a permit five days prior to the regular Town Council meeting. Permits shall be reviewed annually by the Town Council. Renewals are not subject to hearing. The Town Council shall review the permit application at the next regularly scheduled council meeting after the application is received. The permit shall be granted if the applicant meets the requirements of this chapter.
 2. Revocation. The Town Council shall have the right to revoke any permit that may be granted in accordance with this chapter, by giving the holder of such permit at least one week notice to appear before the Town Council to show cause, if they have any, why such permit should not be revoked. 6.16 WMC DOMESTIC FOWL.

In addition to the provisions of WMC Title 6, Animals, the following provisions shall regulate the keeping of poultry within the zoning districts that allow for said use:

- 6.16.010 Chickens Allowed.
It is unlawful for any person to own or have custody or possession of any fowl in the Town except: A person may keep up to ten (10) adult hen chickens on any one premises with a permit granted by the Town Council. The Town Council may grant, deny, condition or revoke a chicken permit as in its reasonable discretion is appropriate for the health, safety and welfare of the public.
- 6.16.030 Maximum Number of Poultry.
It is unlawful for any person to keep more than ten (10) adult hen chickens on any premises within the Town.
- 6.16.040 Keeping Prohibited.
It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to keep within the corporate limits of the Town any roosters, geese or ducks.

6.16.050 Permitting to Run At large Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person owning, possessing, or claiming any chickens to permit or allow such chickens to be at large within the corporate limits of the Town.
